And, Also, Everywhere **Jessica Owings**

October 8-22, 2011

This fall, **threesquared** presents an exhibition of recent works by printmaker Jessica Owings from October 8 through October 22, 2011. *And, Also, Everywhere* will feature prints and paper constructions that utilize discarded books as raw material.

In this exhibition, Owings gracefully relates the subtlety of language to a physical experience. Her works are an attempt to slow down a thought to a fraction of a second and capture, on paper, the infinitesimal moment. With training in fine art and commercial printing, her work merges artistic concepts—often revolving around collaboration, compulsive collection, and random acts of giving—with design constructs. Much of her work is presented as series or sequence using traditionally commercial aspects of printmaking to compose her studio work.

Jessica Owings is an instructor and gallery director of the Leu Center for Visual Arts at Belmont University. She holds a BFA from Bradley University in Peoria, Illinois, and an MFA from University of Tennessee, Knoxville, which she received in 2004. Her writing has been featured in publications such as *Art Papers*, *Number*, and *Review*. Owings's work has been widely exhibited in galleries in cities such as Nashville, Kansas City, Chicago, and New York City.

The opening art party will be held on Saturday, October 8th from 6 to 9 pm. Wine and light refreshments will be served. Parking is free.

Located in the historic Chestnut Square Building, **threesquared** is a contemporary art space dedicated to showcasing artwork that exemplifies the highest standard of aesthetic and technical expertise. **threesquared** is directed by Dane Carder, whose studio space currently houses the gallery.
